# 2010 SUMMER SCHOOL COURSE SCHEDULE

## **High School Math Prep**

**June 7th – 24th**

**Monday - Thursday ~ 8:00 AM - 11:00 AM**

**Cost: \$300**

**No Credit**

The goal of this course is to help students develop the proficiency and confidence they need to succeed in high school mathematics. The focus is on activities designed to reinforce and strengthen basic arithmetic and pre-algebra skills.

*Open to entering freshmen.*

## **High School English Prep**

**June 7th – 24th**

**Monday - Thursday ~ 11:30 AM – 2:30 PM**

**Cost: \$300**

**No Credit**

High School English Prep is designed to help students become more proficient in reading, writing, and vocabulary. Students will be exposed to a variety of learning activities to improve their fundamental English skills.

*Open to entering freshmen.*

## **Speech**

**June 7th – 24th**

**Monday - Thursday ~ 8:00 AM - 11:00 AM**

**OR**

**Monday - Thursday ~ 11:30 AM – 2:30 PM**

**Cost: \$300**

**0.5 Credit**

Students will develop speaking skills through a variety of communication experiences, researching, writing, and presenting persuasive and demonstrative speeches. They will participate in extemporaneous speaking, oral interpretation, group discussion, and debate.

## **Computer Applications**

**June 7th – 24th**

**Monday - Thursday ~ 8:00 AM - 11:00 AM**

**OR**

**Monday - Thursday ~ 11:30 AM – 2:30 PM**

**Cost: \$300**

**0.5 Credit**

Course focuses on use of word processors, spreadsheets and presentation software packages. Fundamentals of a windows operating environment, file manipulation and management, systems setup and basic concepts of networking and computer operations will also be explored.

## **Health**

**Cost: \$300**

**0.5 Credit**

Studies will include mental health, social health, human development, nutrition and fitness, substance abuse, disease prevention, self-esteem, stress management, and goal setting.

*Open to sophomores and above.*

## **Attendance**

Due to the short duration of the summer courses, attendance at all classes, especially the first day, is important. Students should miss a class only for emergencies or illness. Students should notify the instructor via email as soon as they know they will miss a class.

## **Geometry**

**June 7th – July 2nd**

**Monday - Friday ~ 8:00 AM to 11:00 AM**

**OR**

**Monday - Friday ~ 11:30 AM to 2:30 PM**

**Cost: \$450**

**1.0 Credit**

This modern course presents the fundamentals of geometry in both traditional (Euclidean) and analytic (coordinate-based) settings.

*Open to sophomores and above with a C or better in first-year algebra (Math 312, 314, 315 or the equivalent).*

## **Physical Education**

**Monday - Thursday ~ 8:00 AM - 11:00 AM**

**OR**

**Monday - Thursday ~ 11:30 AM – 2:30 PM**

**Cost: \$300**

**0.5 Credit**

Students will focus on health fitness with an emphasis on a flexibility and weight training program. The weight training program will familiarize them with our weight training facility equipment. Students will improve their sports skills through drill exercises and games.
